ACCEPTANCE OF A STATE OF WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
LAKE MONITORING & PROTECTION GRANT

The Land & Water Resources Department has secured a \$21,316 Lake Monitoring & Protection Network grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR).

The purpose of the grant is to implement aquatic invasive species network activities within Dane County. The County will provide technical assistance to communities, stakeholders and volunteers to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species (AIS), to provide education of AIS impacts & prevention and to conduct lake monitoring.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$21,316 Lake Monitoring and Protection Grant from the WI DNR.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Land & Waters Resources Director and the Water Resources Planner are authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds, submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation within six months of project completion, and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete approved projects.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that new revenue and expense accounts LWRADMIN "LMPN GRANT" be established for \$21,316. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
