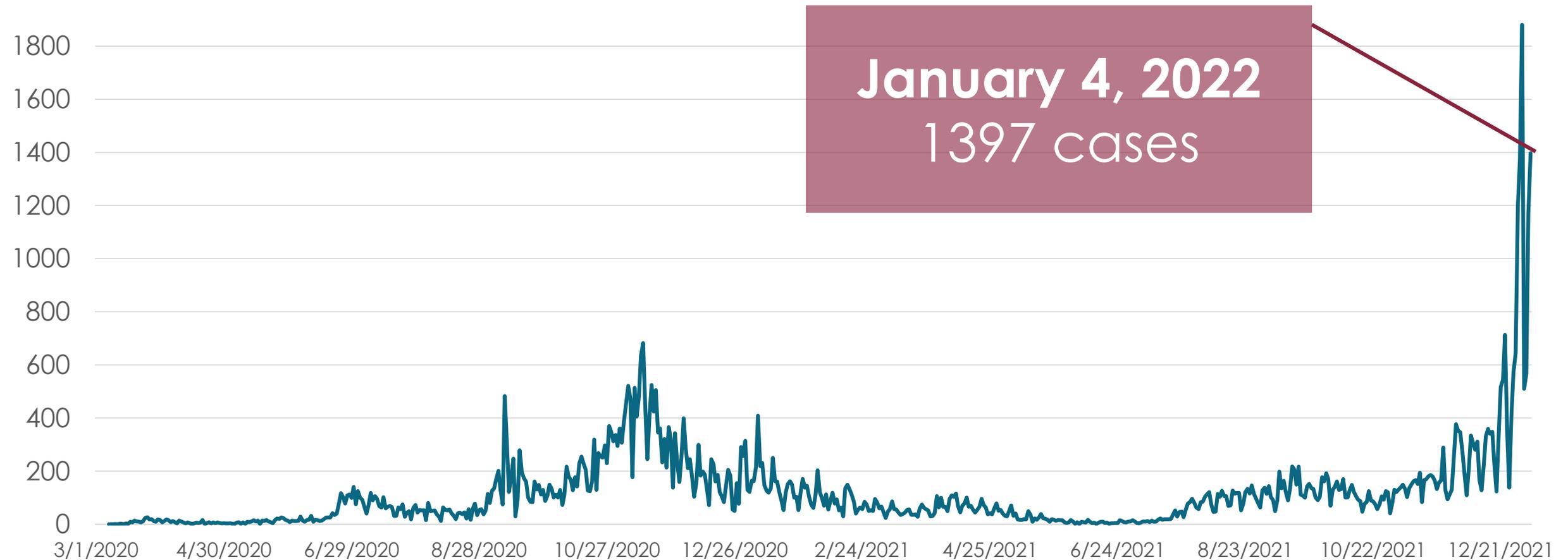

DATA

79,100+ people have tested positive for COVID.



The rate for unvaccinated people is

10.7x as high

as the rate for people fully vaccinated with a booster or additional dose.

Testing Countywide

Last week:

Averaging 4,299 tests/day

This week:

Averaging 5,094 tests/day



COVID-19 Vaccine



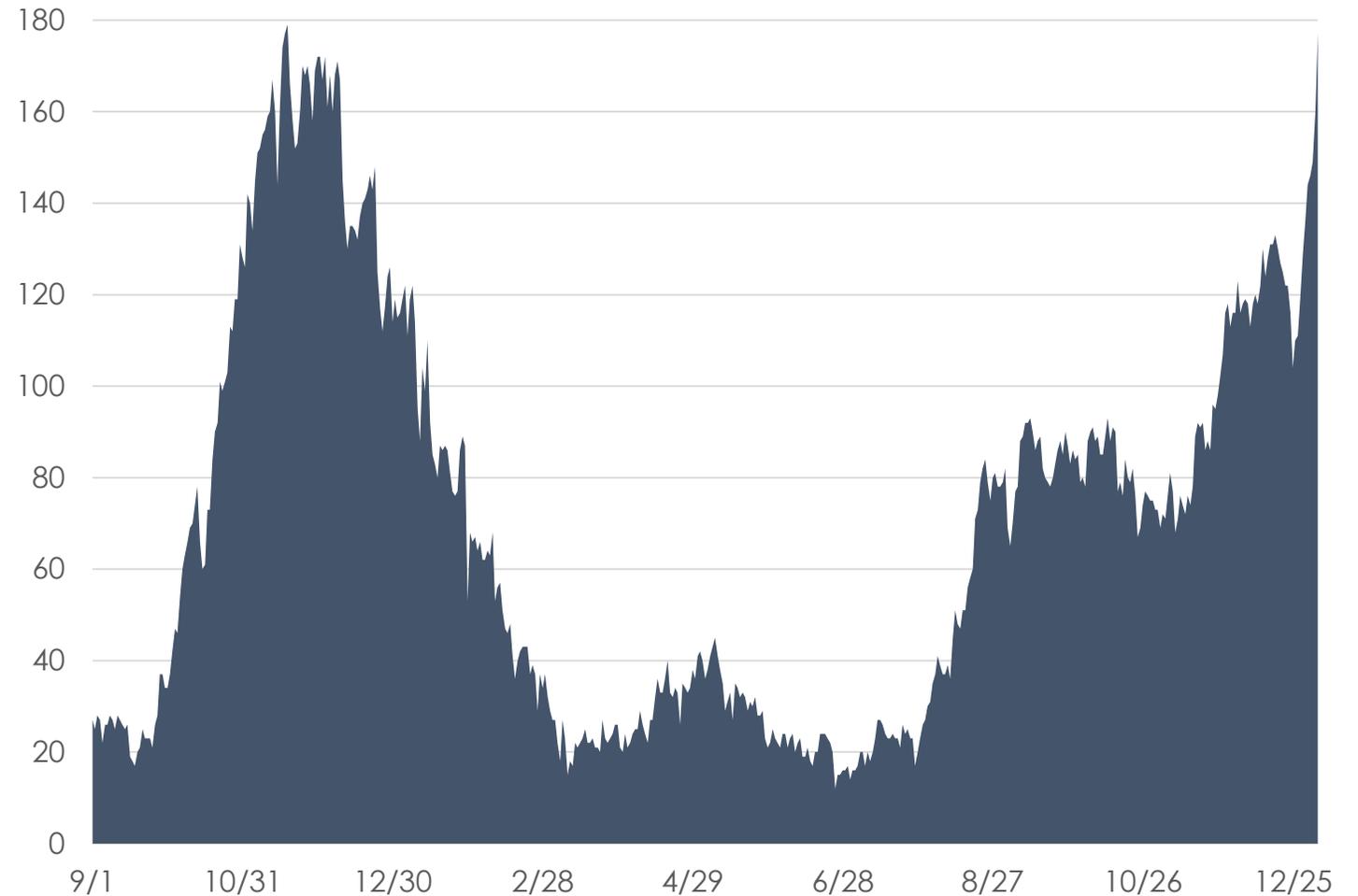
57%

of people who received a full vaccine series in Dane County have received a booster or third dose, up from 36% on December 1.

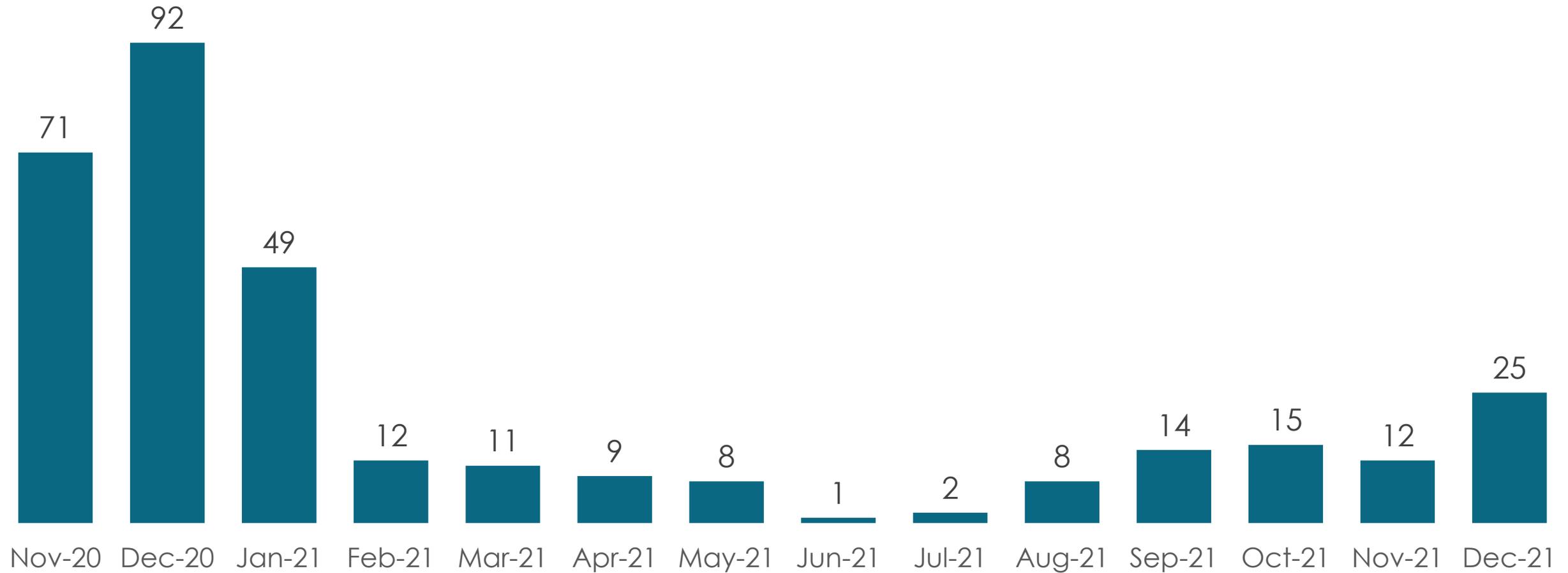
Hospitalizations

Hospitalizations have increased.

Today there are 177 people hospitalized, with 37 in the ICU.

STRATEGIES

Vaccination

December vaccinations at the Arena and PHMDC clinics:

- **7,483** primary and booster doses
- **4,845** doses for ages 5-11



Vaccination– Mobile clinics

We started providing mobile booster and vaccine clinics once more in January 2022

15+ clinics scheduled so far at libraries, community centers, faith communities, shelters, and more

Masks required in

Exception for spaces
where everyone in the
space is fully vaccinated
Expires Feb 1, 2022



Testing

432 test/day capacity at SMO

We have been operating above our capacity every day starting the week of 12/21 due to high walk in volume

Added 1,728 additional tests this week by expanding hours to 8am-8pm every day

Omicron Variant

Cases exponentially rising: 7 day average as of 12/31 was 887.9, leading to concerns about hospital capacity in the future.

We continue to promote boosters and vaccines to prevent hospitalizations and recommend layering protection, like masks and staying home if you have symptoms
