BUDGET AMENDMENT TO MANAGE MEDICATION VENDING MACHINE INITIATIVE

In 2021 Emergency Management began an initiative with Dane County EMS agencies to support medication vending machines. These vending machines allow group purchasing and decreased waste of medications for EMS providers throughout Dane County. This program also allows ambulances to restock immediately after patient transports and resume service in a timely manner. The program is managed through a contract between Dane County and the City of Madison.

Overall, the cost of the medications are recovered from the various agencies who are supplied via the vending machines. The expenditures and revenues associated with the program were not reflected in the 2022 operating budget requiring an adjustment to the Emergency Management department's budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that accounts EMEMS 20310 "Medication Vending Expense" and EMEMS 80134 "Medication Vending Revenue" be increased by \$120,000.
