Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County Parks is partnering with Ducks Unlimited and the US Fish and Wildlife Service on a large wetland and prairie restoration project in the Walking Iron Wildlife Area. The WI Department of Natural Resources has awarded Dane County Parks a \$49,000 Pheasant Stamp Grant to contribute to the project to be used for upland seeding.

Current Policy or Practice -

Acceptance of grant funds requires County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The project has many water quality benefits, including allowing the water to filter through the wetland before it eventually enters the Wisconsin River, increasing groundwater recharge and providing excellent waterfowl and pheasant hunting habitat.
