6 **AUTHORIZING DOWNSTREAM BENEFICIAL USERS CONSENT FOR**
7 **CHEROKEE PARK INC. WATER WITHDRAWAL**

9 Cherokee Park Inc. has applied to the WI DNR for a permit to withdraw water from an
10 unnamed tributary of the Yahara River. Wis. Stats 30.18(3)(a)3 states that the
11 application “shall include written statements of consent to the withdrawal from all riparian
12 owners who are making beneficial use of the water proposed to be withdrawn.” Dane
13 County was identified as a downstream beneficial user as the owner and operator of the
14 Yahara River Locks (Tenney Lock, Babcock Lock and LaFollette Lock).

16 Cherokee Park Inc. intends to pump the water in order to irrigate 93 acres of turfgrass
17 between April 15 and October 15th, up to 70 times per year. The pump capacity is 1800
18 gallons per minute and each application will be 0.15 to 0.25 inches.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Dane County Executive is authorized
to execute a downstream beneficial users consent for Cherokee Park Inc.
