**AUTHORIZING DOWNSTREAM BENEFICIAL USERS CONSENT FOR
CHEROKEE PARK INC. WATER WITHDRAWAL**

Cherokee Park Inc. has applied to the WI DNR for a permit to withdraw water from an unnamed tributary of the Yahara River. Wis. Stats 30.18(3)(a)3 states that the application “shall include written statements of consent to the withdrawal from all riparian owners who are making beneficial use of the water proposed to be withdrawn.” Dane County was identified as a downstream beneficial user as the owner and operator of the Yahara River Locks (Tenney Lock, Babcock Lock and LaFollette Lock).

Cherokee Park Inc. intends to pump the water in order to irrigate 93 acres of turfgrass between April 15 and October 15th, up to 70 times per year. The pump capacity is 1800 gallons per minute and each application will be 0.15 to 0.25 inches.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Executive is authorized to execute a downstream beneficial users consent for Cherokee Park Inc.

Downstream Beneficial Users Consent

County of Dane, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Madison, WI 53703, a riparian beneficial user of Tenney (Lake Mendota), Babcock (Lakes Monona and Waubesa) and LaFollette (Lake Kegonsa) lock and dams, having been requested by Cherokee Park, Inc., who is proposed to divert up to 4.01 cfs at intervals up to 70 times during the growing season for a total annual volume of approximately 34,214,400.35 gallons from the unnamed tributary to the Yahara River (WBIC 806300) located in the Town of Westport, Dane County, to acknowledge that diversion. Dane County deploys operational strategies for the dams necessary to comply with lake level orders set by WI DNR. It is understood that the proposed diversion would be of nonsurplus water and that it is the responsibility of the WI DNR to determine if the use adversely affects lake levels. Dane County acknowledges that WI DNR may issue a permit for the diversion and Dane County shall not be liable or responsible for operational strategies that are ineffective during periods of drought.
