

ACCEPTANCE OF 2022 CLEAN BOATS CLEAN WATERS GRANT FUNDS  
FROM THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND TRANSFER LTE FUNDS  
FOR LAKE MONITORING & PROTECTION GRANT

The Land & Water Resources Department has secured a \$4,000 Clean Boats Clean Waters grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR).

The purpose of the grant is to provide watercraft inspectors at county lake access sites during the summer months to conduct inspections, provide aquatic invasive species information, collect and report data, and report suspected specimens. The required match for this project is met by in-kind county expenditures for fuel, mileage and additional staff hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$4,000 Clean Boats Clean Waters grant from the WI DNR,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Land & Waters Resources Director and the Water Resources Planner are authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds,

Transfer \$4,306 from LMPN Grant expense account LWRADMIN 20142 to the LTE-Invasive Species account to also utilize the LTE personnel for aquatic invasive species activities under the Lake Monitoring & Protection Grant.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that LWRADMIN account 80122 CLCW Grant Revenue shall be increased by \$4,000. Account LWRADMIN 20142 LMPN Grant Expense shall be reduced by \$4,306. Account LWRADMIN 10105 LTE-Invasive Species shall be increased by \$7,716 and LWRADMIN 10108 Social Security shall be increased by \$590. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
