


Adler Addition to Dunkirk Dam Lake District and Town of Dunkirk Park Lands

Partners: Town of Dunkirk, Dunkirk Dam Lake District, Groundswell Conservancy

- Acquisition of 1.64 acres of wooded land on the Yahara River; off CTH N
 - o Approx. 225 feet of Yahara River frontage
- The property will protect open space and provide public access and increase water based recreational capacity on the river.
- Ownership: Town of Dunkirk
- Management: Dunkirk Dam Lake District
 - o Construct accessible public canoe/kayak launch with an accessible path
 - o Install at least 1 accessible fishing pier
- Estimated Total project costs: \$39,000
 - o Purchase Price: \$33,000 (based on appraisal)
 - o Tentative Knowles Nelson Stewardship Grant for 50%
 - o Dane County Conservation Fund application: \$19,500




Adler Family parcel, 1.6 acres,

- Dunkirk Dam Lake District


