

ACCEPTANCE OF A NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CONSERVATION DISTRICTS 2022
TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

The Land & Water Resources Department has secured a \$154,500 technical assistance grant from the National Association of Conservation Districts (NACD).

The purpose of the grant is to increase the availability of technical assistance to Land Conservation Division customers for the implementation of soil and water conservation projects funded through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) – Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP). The funding offsets the costs associated with providing technical assistance by existing Land Conservation Division staff and provides funding for a limited term employee (LTE).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$154,500 Technical Assistance Grant from NACD.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive and County Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of Dane County.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that account LWRCONSV 80156 NACD TA Grant Revenue be increased \$154,500, account LWRCONSV 10111 LTE NACD TA Grant Expense be increased \$40,000 and account LWRCONSV 10108 Social Security Expense be increased \$3,060. All funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
