Brief Description of Proposal -

W&R requested a waiver of bid and received approval from the Personnel and Finance committee on December 12, 2022 to utilize Busch for supply of service, parts and consumables. W&R subsequently negotiated a new contract with the company. The term of the contract is 2 years with 3 optional years. Busch Consolidated Inc and W&R wish to enter into an Agreement for Vacuum Pump service, parts & consumables with a total amount of \$490,000.
