7	The demand for veteran's services has continued to increase. The 2023 operating budget		
8	increased staffing in the Dane County Veterans Service Office by 1.5 FTE. In the effort to recruit		
9	for these positions, the office has found zero interest among applicants for the 0.5 FTE position.		
10			
11	Fortunately, the office has received notice from the State of Wisconsin of increased grant		
12	revenue for 2023 in the amount of \$19,178 that is to be applied toward increasing access to		
13	services. These additional funds, combined with application of carryforward funds in the Vets		
14	Ride with Pride expense line, funding is available to increase position #3101 from a 0.5 to 1.0		
15	FTE staring March 12, 2023.

17	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that, position #3101 be increased from a 0.5 FTE to a 1.0 FTE with		
18	a start date of March 12, 2023 and that the following lines in the 2023 be adjusted:
