AUTHORIZING ACCCEPTANCE OF PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON DANE COUNTY ROADMAP TO REDUCING VIOLENCE GRANT FUNDS IN THE CRIME RESPONSE PROGRAM OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

The Crime Response Program of the District Attorney's Office was awarded a PHMDC Roadmap to Reducing Violence Grant in the amount of \$40,110 for the purchase of Response Technologies, Centurion Elite Emergency Notification System & 50 GPS Anywhere Bluetooth panic buttons to be paired with a victim's smartphone. When activated, Centurion Anywhere will send user's GPS location along with alarm information to Dane County Emergency Dispatch. These funds will be utilized to enhance the safety options for victims of crime.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney's Office, Crime Response Program is hereby authorized to accept \$40,110 of PHMDC grant funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following accounts be set up in the District Attorney's Crime Response Program (DACRIME) to account for receipt and expenditure of the funds:
