

**AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON DANE COUNTY
ROADMAP TO REDUCING VIOLENCE GRANT FUNDS IN THE CRIME RESPONSE
PROGRAM OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE**

The Crime Response Program of the District Attorney's Office was awarded a PHMDC Roadmap to Reducing Violence Grant in the amount of \$40,110 for the purchase of Response Technologies, Centurion Elite Emergency Notification System & 50 GPS Anywhere Bluetooth panic buttons to be paired with a victim's smartphone. When activated, Centurion Anywhere will send user's GPS location along with alarm information to Dane County Emergency Dispatch. These funds will be utilized to enhance the safety options for victims of crime.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney's Office, Crime Response Program is hereby authorized to accept \$40,110 of PHMDC grant funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following accounts be set up in the District Attorney's Crime Response Program (DACRIME) to account for receipt and expenditure of the funds:

DACRIME (NEW) Roadmap to Reducing Violence Ex \$40,110

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the above accounts be carried forward until expended.



DANE COUNTY CONTRACT

ADDENDUM # 13824A

Revised 01/2022

THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into effective as of the date by which both parties hereto have executed this document, by and between the County of Dane (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Response Technologies, LTD. (hereinafter, "Provider").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS Provider and County, by a separate document (hereinafter, the "Master Agreement"), Dane County Contract # 13824 , have previously entered into a contractual relationship pursuant to which Provider Response Technologies, LTD., and

WHEREAS County and Provider wish to amend the Master Agreement in order to increase the contract by \$40,110.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by each party for itself, the parties do agree as follows:

1. The Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unchanged in any manner by this addendum except as changes are expressly set forth herein. This addendum shall control only to the extent of any conflict between the terms of the Master Agreement and this addendum.
2. The Master Agreement, and any amendment or addendum to it, may be executed and transmitted to any other party by legible facsimile reproduction or by scanned legible electronic PDF copy, and utilized in all respects as, an original, wet-inked manually executed document. Further, the Master Agreement and any amendment or addendum thereto, may be stored and reproduced by each party electronically, photographically, by photocopy or other similar process, and each party may at its option destroy any original document so reproduced. All parties hereto stipulate that any such legible reproduction shall be admissible in evidence as the original itself in any judicial, arbitration or administrative proceeding whether or not the original is in existence and whether or not such reproduction was made by each party in the regular course of business. This term does not apply to the service of notices under the Master Agreement, or any subsequent amendment or addendum.
3. The contract amount shall be increased by \$40110 for the purchase of Response Technologies, Centurion Elite Emergency Notification System and 50 GPS Anywhere Bluetooth panic buttons. The Crime Response Program of the Dane County District Attorney's Office was awarded these funds in support of the Public Health Madison & Dane County 2022 RFP: Roadmap to Reducing Violence in Madison and Dane County.
