ADDRESSING THE NEEDS OF THE HOMELESS
Unmet needs persist for Dane County's homeless residents, including the need for family
shelter and transportation. While the shelter system is required to accept the homeless in the
winter, the number of families turned away from shelter in the summer is a major issue.
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the 2015 Capital Budget be increased by \$5,000 to
allow the Department of Human Services to purchase a van to be used to transport homeless
individuals to services.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the allocation for services in the Department of Human
Services operating budget be increased by \$3,500 for operation of the second van for homeless
individuals.
individuals.
BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that \$100,000 be transferred from the General Fund to a new
purchase of service line item to provide additional funding for services for the homeless.
