AMENDING CHAPTER 25 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, INCREASING THE LIVING WAGE
The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:
ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.
ARTICLE 2. Section 25.015(1)(f) is amended to read as follows: (f) <i>Living wage</i> means an hourly wage equal to <u>100_129</u> % of the poverty level divided by 2080.
1. The <u>129%</u> living wage shall first take effect January 1, <u>2000</u> <u>2016</u> except that <u>it the 100% living wage</u> shall <u>be continue</u> in effect as of January 1, 1999 for human services department purchase-of-service providers covered by this ordinance until the county receives relief from the state levy limits under Wis.
Stats s. 66.0602 either by statutory amendment or levy cap referendum.
[EXPLANATION: This amendment increases the living wage to 129% of the poverty level and exempts human services department purchase of service contracts.]
