ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO REVISE CHAPTER 17 FLOODPLAIN ZONING: LOWER WISCONSIN RIVER STUDY (FIS), REMOVAL OF AREAS WHICH HAVE BEEN INCORPORATED (VILLAGE OF WINDSOR), AND HIGHWAY 19 TRIBUTARY LETTER OF MAP REVISION.

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This amendment adopts a FEMA Flood Insurance Study and associated Flood Insurance Rate Maps for the Lower Wisconsin River into the regulatory floodplain maps for rural Dane County. It also incorporates a FEMA Letter of Map Revision for a Highway 19 Tributary project in the Town of Burke. Finally it removes Flood Insurance Rate Map panels for areas which have been incorporated (Village of Windsor).

Current Policy or Practice -

Amendments to the official floodplain map require County Board approval follwing a recommendation and public hearing before the Zoning and Land Regulation committee.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Regulation of Chapter 17 will be based on latest data provided by FEMA. The County remains in compliance with FEMA requirements and eligible for land owners to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program.
