AUTHORIZING A RAPID RESPONSE AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES (AIS) GRANT FOR INDIAN LAKE FROM THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

- 5 The Land & Water Resources Department (LWRD) has obtained a cost share grant from the 6 Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for the purposes of removing common 7 carp and monitoring in-lake improvements at Indian Lake. Indian Lake is located within Indian 8 Lake County Park in the Town of Berry.

The purpose of the grant is to provide Dane County LWRD the ability to further reduce the
common carp population in Indian Lake through commercial fishing. The water quality
improvements will be documented through a monitoring plan including the use of sonar and
standard chemical analysis. The required match for this project would be met by in-kind county
expenditures for fuel, mileage and additional staff hours.
