Title

Repeal and recreate Section 12.325 of the Madison General Ordinances to limit persons entering or staying on highways.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This is a public safety measure that limits persons from entering a highway and approaching a vehicle that is in operation. It also limits a person from staying upon the median of any highway. The ordinance provides exceptions for crossing at crosswalks, getting into or out of a vehicle, highway maintenance and others.

Chapter 12, MGO, adopts the definitions in the State traffic laws. In those laws, "Highway" is defined as "all public ways and thoroughfares and bridges on the same. It includes the entire width between the boundary lines of every way open to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purposes of vehicular travel. It includes those roads or driveways in the state, county or municipal parks and in state forests which have been opened to the use of the public for the purpose of vehicular travel and roads or driveways upon the grounds of public schools, as defined in s. 115.01 (1), and institutions under the jurisdiction of the county board of supervisors, but does not include private roads or driveways as defined in sub. (46)." Wis.

Stats. § 340.01(22).

Mayor Soglin was the sponsor of another ordinance, Legistar ID #42503, which should be placed on file and this proposal considered in its place.
