Responses to Letters re nonconforming mineral extraction

Motion by Elleson, second by Haley to take this item out of order on the agenda. Motion carried.

The subcommittee heard public comment on this item.

The subcommittee received written comments on proposed language changes from the Dane County Association of Aggregate Producers.

Robert Procter, representing the Realtors Association of South Central Wisconsin, spoke in opposition to removing current ordinance language that grants registered mineral extraction sites permanent legal nonconforming status.

Chad Lawler, representing the Madison Area Builders Association, spoke about concerns that regulations and difficulty in acquiring local mineral product could lead to increased housing costs.

Mike Lawton, attorney representing Yahara Materials, presented written comments on proposed mineral extraction language.

Bill Buglass, representing Payne and Dolan, spoke about applicant's ability to withdraw a CUP application if they don't wish to pay 3rd-party consultant fees, and expressed support for the idea of a streamlined administrative renewal process.

ZLR Chair Mary Kolar spoke to the subcommittee about her desire for subcommittee input on this issue, without disrupting the subcommittee's other work on the comprehensive revision.

Motion by O'Loughlin, Second by Temple, to request the ZLR Chair appoint a work group to review the issue of legal nonconforming mineral extraction sites and report back to the subcommittee by July 17. The subcommittee directed staff to continue to work with stakeholders to refine proposed language related to Conditional Use Permits for mineral extraction.
