Revising Chapter 48 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances, revising regulation of tattooing and piercing

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The body art program was recently moved from the Sate Department of Health Services to the Department of Regulation and Licensing, this ordinance amendment makes administrative changes to reflect the state changes. This amendment removes the requirement that ear piercers are licensed. This amendment adds in reinspection fees if PHMDC needs to return to an establishment for follow up on written violations.

Current Policy or Practice -

PHMDC currently contracts with DSPS for inspection of body art establishments; however, this ordinance refers to state regulations that have changed due to the change at the state level.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Aligns regulations with the State, removes licensing requirement for ear piercers, allows PHMDC to charge for a re inspection if needed.
