3	APPROVING AGREEMENTS AND
4	SUPPORTING THE OAK RIDGE AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT
5	IN THE CITY OF MIDDLETON

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8	The 2016 Capital Budget included the Affordable Housing Development Fund. This
9	fund is to be used to support affordable housing projects in Dane County. A Request
10	for Proposals (RFP) was issued by the AHDF staff team. As a result, four projects were
11	selected for funding. One of the projects is the Oak Ridge Project located in the City of
12	Middleton. The project, being developed by J.T. Klien, Inc., was selected to receive low
13	income housing tax credits by the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development
14	Authority. The development will include a total of 83 housing units, of which, 60 will be
15	set aside for households with incomes between 30 and 60% of the local median
16	income. 7 of the income restricted units are 3 bedroom units which will be reserved for
17	"Grand Families" a growing type of household where grandparents raise their
18	grandchildren. This project was awarded \$665,000 through the AHDF RFP process.
19	
20	County staff have developed the required documents to transmit the funding to J.T.
21	Klien, Inc. The agreements utilize a partnership between Dane County and the Dane
22	County Housing Authority to provide long term loan to J.T. Klien to contribute to the
23	financing of the project. The agreements also include requirements that J.T. Klien
24	report any evictions to the County as required in 2015 RES-156.
25	
26	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the agreements related to the Affordable Housing
27	Development Fund award to J.T. Klien, Inc. for the purposes of developing a Low
28	Income Housing Tax Credit Project known as Oak Ridge in the City of Middleton are
29	approved and the County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to execute the
30	documents and the County Controller is authorized to issue payments required under
31	the agreements.
