

Dane County Parks Notice Proposed 2018 Fee Increases

The Dane County Park Commission will hold a Public Hearing on the proposed 2018 fee increases at 6:00 PM, Wednesday, September 27, 2017 at the Lyman Anderson Agriculture and Conservation Center, 5201 Fen Oak Drive, Madison WI 53718.

Cooperative Program Fees

In 2017, a \$5.00 increase was proposed for the Cooperative Dog Park and Lake Access programs. The cooperating agencies agreed to split the increase over a two-year period 2017 and 2018.

Dog Park Fee (Dane County, City of Madison, Middleton and Sun Prairie)

Increase Annual Permit by \$5.00 over a two-year period 2017 and 2018.

- o 2017 Increase \$2.00 to \$32.00
- o 2018 Increase \$3.00 to \$35.00
- O Disabled, Senior and Additional Dog will be 50% of the Annual Dog Fee, rounded down to the nearest dollar. The 2018 increase is \$1.00 from \$16.00 to \$17.00

Additional revenues will help offset the additional costs of adding portable toilets, large dog waste bags and increased grounds maintenance for the County Dog Parks.

Lake Access Fee (Dane County, City of Madison and City of Monona)

Increase Annual Permit by \$5.00 over a two-year period 2017 and 2018.

Resident Annual

- o 2017 Increase \$2.00 to \$37.00
- o 2018 Increase \$3.00 to \$40.00

Non-Resident Annual

- o 2017 Increase \$2.00 to \$47.00
- o 2018 Increase \$3.00 to \$50.00

Resident Senior, Non-Resident Senior, Disabled, 2nd Vehicle & Replacements will **increase \$1.00**. Additional revenues will help offset increased costs for the maintenance and operation of the Lake Access facilities.
