7 8	The 2016 Capital Budget included the Affordable Housing Development Fund. This
9	fund is to be used to support affordable housing projects in Dane County. A Request
10 11	for Proposals (RFP) was issued by the AHDF staff team. As a result, four projects were selected for funding. One of the projects is the Oak Ridge Project located in the City of
12	Middleton. The project, being developed by J.T. Klien Company, Inc., was selected to
13 14	receive low income housing tax credits by the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority. The development will include a total of 83 housing units, of
15	which, 60-70 will be set aside for households with incomes between 30 and 60% of the
16 17	local median income. 7 of the income restricted units are 3 bedroom units which will be reserved targeted for "Grand Families" a growing type of household where grandparents
18	raise their grandchildren. This project was awarded \$665,000 through the AHDF RFP
19 20	process.
21	County staff have developed the required documents to transmit the funding to J.T.
22 23	Klien <u>Company</u> , Inc. The agreements utilize a partnership between Dane County and the Dane County Housing Authority to provide long term loan to J.T. Klien <u>Company</u> ,
24	Inc. to contribute to the financing of the project. The agreements also include
25   26	requirements that J.T. Klien <u>Company, Inc.</u> report any evictions to the County as required in 2015 RES-156.
27	THEREFORE REAL ACCOUNTED that the extrements related to the Affordable Heuring
28 29	THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the agreements related to the Affordable Housing Development Fund award to J.T. Klien <u>Company</u> , Inc. for the purposes of developing a
30 31	Low Income Housing Tax Credit Project known as Oak Ridge in the City of Middleton
31 32	are approved and the County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to execute the documents and the County Controller is authorized to issue payments required under
