

ACCEPTANCE OF A NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CONSERVATION DISTRICTS
2021 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

The Land & Water Resources Department as secured a \$150,000 technical assistance grant from the National Association of Conservation Districts (NACD).

The purpose of the grant is to increase the availability of technical assistance to Land Conservation Division customers for the implementation of soil and water conservation projects funded through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) – Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP). The funding offsets the costs associated with providing technical assistance by existing Land Conservation Division staff and provides funding for a limited term employee (LTE).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$150,000 Technical Assistance Grant from NACD.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the new revenue account LWRCONSV “NACD TA Grant” be established for \$150,000 and the new expense account LWRCONSV “LTE NACD TA Grant” be established for \$46,447. Account LWRCONSV 10108 Social Security Expense shall also be increased \$3,553. All funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
