AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF LTE HOURS IN THE LAND & WATER  
RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

The Dane County Land & Water Resources Department employs limited term employees to assist with sediment removal along the Yahara River and to support our park visitors and volunteers.

Dane County's Civil Service Ordinance, section 18.16(1)(a), limits limited term employees to 1,200 hours per year. Five employees in these positions are approaching the limit for LTE's, and the Land & Water Resources Department is requesting an extension of hours to allow staff to continue assisting in the essential work of the department.

The budget contains sufficient funds to support these positions for the remainder of the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors grants an exception to Dane County Ordinance 18.16(1)(a) to allow the LTE Park Ranger Cadet, LTE Park Restoration and Management Coordinator, 2 LTE Lake Management Harvester Mechanics and the LTE Skilled Laborer with the Department of Waste & Renewables to exceed 1,200 hours in the 2021 calendar year.
