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3	ACCEPTING YOUTH JUSTICE INNOVATIONS GRANT		
4	THE STATE OF WISCOSNSIN DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES		
5	DCDHS – CYF DIVISION		
6			
7	The Wisconsin Department of Children and Families has awarded Youth Justice Innovations		
8	grant funds to Dane County Department of Human Services (DCDHS) Children, Youth and		
9	Families (CYF) Division to address the needs of youth. Beginning October 1, 2021, DCDHS is		
10	receiving funds to support youth and families who are system involved as well as training for		
11	staff and system partners.		
12 13	Dane County has identified a variety of service gaps and needs through a number of different		
14	initiatives including, but not limited to the revamped 2019 DMC Report (Disproportionate		
15	Minority Contact), the Dane County Violence Prevention Coalition Report Violence Prevention		
16	Roadmap Report the Dane Restorative Justice Coalition and the development of the YASI		
17	Service Matrix. Through this process a gap in services regarding restorative interventions has		
18	been identified.		
19			
20	Restorative justice interventions for youth in Dane County are currently only targeted to youth		
21	who receive municipal citations. Through this grant we will extend similar services to youth		
22	referred for state charges via Victim Offender Conferences (VOC) and Restorative Justice		
23	Circles (RJC). We will subcontract with Briarpatch Youth Services (BYS) who has a long history		
24	of providing these types of services.		
25			
26	The need for more supportive interventions has also been identified. We will set up training for		
27	DCDHS staff and system partners. We will engage the Carey Group training staff to conduct 6		
28	training sessions (120 participants) including DCDHS staff and system partners.		
29			
30	The total amount of funds awarded to DCDHS by the State of Wisconsin total \$150,000 for the		
31	period of October 1, 2021 – December 31, 2022. This resolution authorizes the use of those		
32	funds.		
33	NOW THEREFORE BE IT DECOLVED to 4 the fellowing and an angle of the second seco		
34	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following new expenditure and revenue		
35	accounts be added to the Children, Youth and Families section in the Department of Human		
36 37	Services; and		
38	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following revenue account be adjusted and that the		
39	revenue increase be credited to the General Fund and transferred from the General Fund to the		
40	following expenditure account in the Department of Human Services:
