## DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON SELECTION OF PRIORITIES IN 2017-19 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

Chair Corrigan indicated that the intention is to highlight top issue priorities for the County board's 2017-2019 legislative agenda, which will be sent to members of the county's legislative delegation. Priorities were submitted by each standing committee.

After discussion, the committee agreed by consensus that the following legislative agenda items would comprise the County Board's legislative agenda priority list (not in a particular ranked order):

- Racial Equity: The elimination of racial disparities and the elevation of racial equity are among the most important priorities and responsibilities of Dane County. Specific areas that help alleviate racial disparities include Child Welfare, Economic Wellbeing, Family Structure, Youth Initiatives, Education, Prevention, Employment, Criminal Justice, Health Care, Housing, Transportation, Economic Development, Contracting and Service Delivery.
- Local Transportation
- District Attorney Funding
- Renewable Energy
- Water Quality
- Recycling
- Keeping 17 year-olds in the juvenile justice system
- Homeless Services
- Oppose any legislation that imposes requirements on the receipt of public assistance
- Support local control/ oppose state legislative efforts to reduce local government control
- Rural Broadband

#### UPDATE ON UNIVERCITY ALLIANCE PROJECT

Chair Corrigan updated the committee regarding an application that has been submitted on behalf of the County Board to the UniverCITY Alliance. If awarded, the project would begin in Fall 2017 and would utilize multidisciplinary groups from UW Madison departments and courses to conduct evaluations and best practice research on policies around the following policy and program evaluation topics that have been prioritized by the Executive Committee: including affordable housing, economic development, high-volume users of county services, water quality.
