Supervisor Willett spoke in support of the resolution. The committee members voted to postpone action on the resolution in committee because they had concerns regarding the resolution and asked Supervisor Willett to address several things and bring an amended resolution back to the committee:

1) It should be redrafted to focus specifically on requesting more staff and resources for the District Attorney's Office rather than focusing on specific crimes that are both criminal and civil issues.

2) The committee would like the DA to weigh in on the resolution

3) The Chair would like to see any discussion of extra staff and resources for the DA's Office to indicate that those additional resources would be directed toward creating extra capacity for deferred prosecution programs and restorative court. The Chair indicated that the DA's office has said a number of the violent crimes mentioned in the current resolution are already their priority with their current resources.

A motion was made by SCHMIDT, seconded by STUBBS, that the resolution be postponed indefinitely in committee until it is redrafted and brought back by the sponsor. The motion carried by a voice vote (7-0).
