- 2000 2006: roundtable / identified mutual interest projects
- 2007: formally developed "pin map"
- 2008: network engineering / BTOP grant submission
- 2009: won \$8.86MM BTOP grant from NTIA
- 2010 2012: built network / bootstrapped operations
- 2013: formed MUFN-Consortium, Unincorporated Association
- 2014: received 501(c)4 designation from IRS

- Members share the cost of new fiber builds per their discretion

MUFN ROLE

- Brokers fiber builds and allocation among members
- Facilitates fiber builds and allocation among members
- Runs MUFN Operations
- Monitors sustainability of the MUFN Network
