DCL Standards

I convened a Standards workgroup last fall and we came up with some proposed changes to the Standards that allow libraries more flexibility in how they utilize their materials budgets. The discussion came out of our contracting with RTL. I've included the proposed changes in the March Board packet for discussion and review. DCLB will vote to approve these in May; they will then go to all library boards for their approval before final approval at the Board of Supervisors.
