

Hi Rachel,

Attached are our participation lists from yesterday's Election.

Please be aware of the following:

- On the in person participation list and count, voter #1602 was an absentee ballot. It should have been checked in on the absentee listing and checked in as an absentee, rather than in person but due to BadgerBook errors, we were unable to do so.
- At approximately 7 pm, it was discovered that we had one more voter than ballots counted. The numbers had balanced at 6 pm, so the issue had occurred within the past hour. In reviewing all of the possible explanations and doing a search of the polling place, it was discovered that unbeknownst to the Election Inspectors a voter (somewhere between #1400 and 1570) had chosen not to cast their ballot and instead destroyed it and placed it in a garbage can. We have no way to determine which specific voter this was.

So, the total in person participation is 1601 with only 1600 ballots cast and total absentee participation is 708 for a total participation of 2309 with only 2308 ballots cast.
