
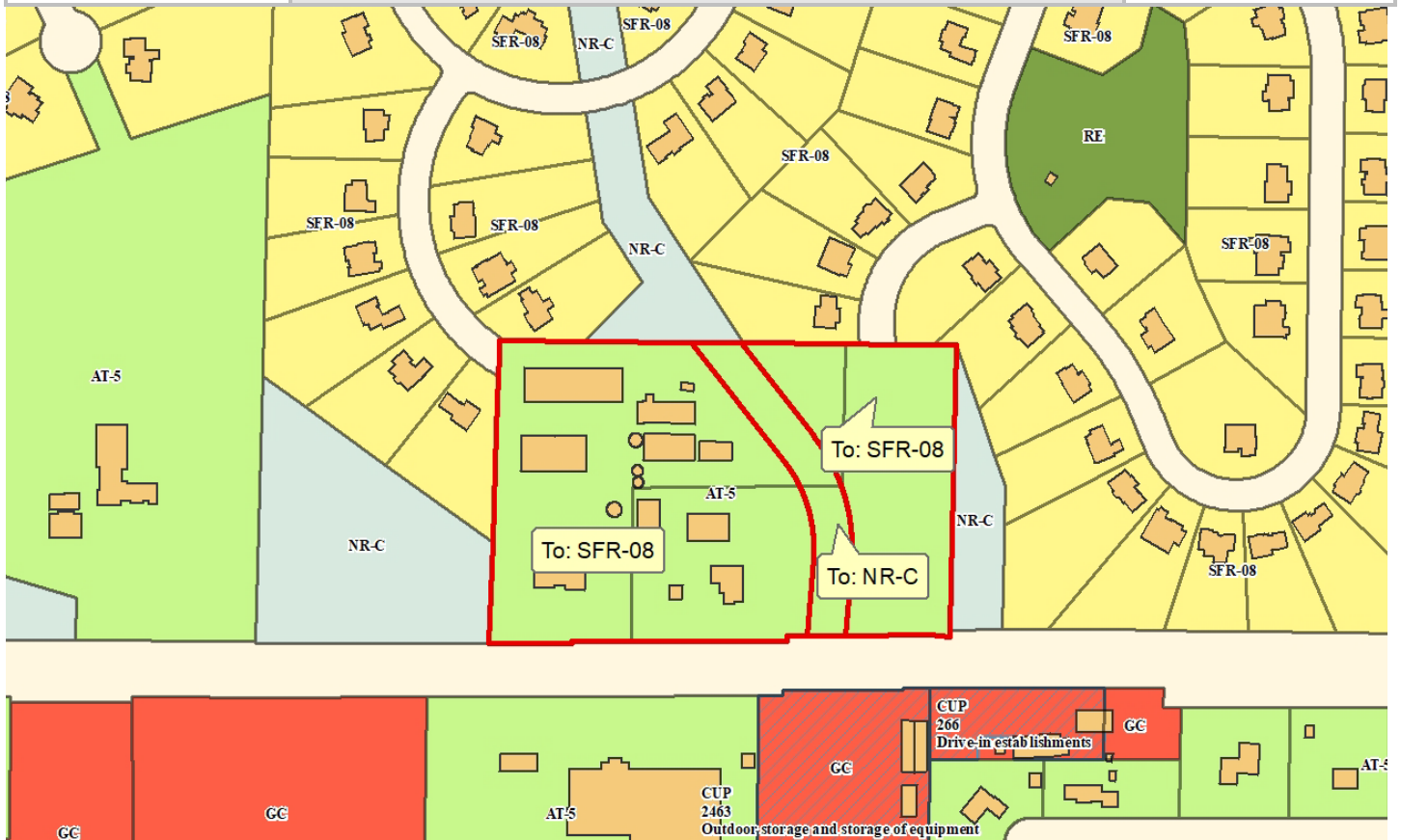

DESCRIPTION: The applicant would like to create 7 residential lots through the rezone and plat process. First step is to rezone the parcels from AT-5 to SFR-08. Lots average around 1.5 acres each, residential lot average is 0.75 to 1 acre.

OBSERVATIONS: Only the 2 existing homes would be accessing Mineral Point Rd. All new lots would access Bell-Vine Ct. or English Daisy Ct. Those 2 local streets would get cul-de-sac terminations.

TOWN PLAN: Town generally wants much of the residential CSM lots or platted lots rezoned to SFR-08 regardless of size.

RESOURCE PROTECTION: There are no resource protection areas on site but there is a drainage swale that bisects the site north to south. The swale is used to create parcel lines (edges) so no one new residential parcel has its building envelope impacted by the swale.

TOWN: The Town approved with the addition of the proposed NR-C zoning area added as an out lot to the plat. Town Condition was to update the application with the County, the applicant has done that.
