Thanks, this is helpful. Can you give me an idea of what the parking capacity would be if the lot is developed as proposed in the site plan?

Since I last communicated with you, I have been made aware of additional issues that will also need to be addressed before I will be comfortable recommending approval of Petition 11870 to the Zoning and Land Regulations Committee. As there will be additional impervious surface area and land disturbance, this will affect any stormwater plans and controls on the property. I've cc'd LWRD Stormwater Engineer Theresa Nelson on this e-mail. I understand from Theresa that the site is currently out of compliance with previously issued stormwater plans and stormwater management permits issued under Chapter 14, Dane County Code. Section 10.101(8)(b) of the <u>Dane County Zoning Code</u> includes the following language:

(b) The zoning committee may postpone action on any rezone petition until any unresolved violations of this Chapter or Chapters 11, 12, 13, 14, 17, 74, 75 or 78 are corrected and the property brought into full compliance with applicable standards.

Please work with Theresa to resolve any outstanding Chapter 14 issues as soon as possible. If those issues remain outstanding by August 12, when I finish my staff report to ZLR, I will recommend postponement until LWRD indicates that the property is in compliance with Chapter 14 standards.
