## AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH VERIZON WIRELESS

## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Verizon Wireless Personal Services (Verizon) is requesting an amendment to the license agreement to align with the recent Ruling and Order by the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). The change would reduce the amount Verizon pays to Dane County to lease space on the outdoor warning siren utility poles to \$250 per pole per year.

## Current Policy or Practice -

Verizon currently leases space on the warning siren utility poles at a cost of \$250 per month per pole.

## Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The adoption of this proposal would reduce the revenue from the siren site license agreement from \$18,000 per year to \$1,620 per year.
