All units will be affordable. Eleven (11) units will be income 12 restricted to those earning less than 30% area median income (AMI), eleven (11) units will be 13 restricted to those earning less than 40% AMI, eleven (11) units will be restricted to those 14 earning less than 50% AMI, and the remaining eleven (11) units will restricted to those earning 15 less than 60% AMI. Eleven (11) units will be targeted to homeless individuals/families on the 16 community by-name list who are receiving case management services. 17 18 The County's support includes a grant from the County to the Dane County Housing 19 Authority. The housing authority will then make a loan to the project owner. The terms of the 20 loan include interest only payments of 1% for a 40 year term. The principal of the loan will be 21 due to the housing authority at the end of the loan. 22 23 NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED that the County Executive. County Clerk and County 24 Real Estate staff are authorized to execute the grant agreement and related documents to 25 support the affordable housing project at 651 Mifflin St, Madison, and that the Dane County 26 Controller's Office is authorized to make payments related to the execution of the grant

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agreement.
