The program serves inmates in the Dane County Jail who are going through withdrawal from opioid dependence. Services include assessment, withdrawal management, substance use disorder treatment, case management, the provision of naltrexone injection prior to release from jail, and discharge planning and coordination to community-based follow-up services. These services are jail-based interventions provided by Wellpath staff and they are fully integrated into Wellpath's other health care services provided in the Dane Cunty Jail.
