## AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE YAHARA WATERSHED IMPROVEMENT NETWORK

### Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County currently provides services to WINS through an agreement that runs from 2017-2021. A new agreement has been developed to cover a three (3) year period beginning January 2022 and ending December 2024. The revenue and staffing to support the agreement have been included in the 2022 Land & Water Resources Department budget.

## Current Policy or Practice -

Agreements between Dane County and Municipalities require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The regulatory obligations of the WINS municipalities align with Dane County's voluntary efforts to improve water quality throughout the county, which includes a significant portion of the Yahara River Watershed.
