Course training will provide attendees with knowledge and physical skills required to 16 isolate, distract, and neutralize active shooter threats to protect and meet the needs of the 17 community. Tactical response teams are comprised of highly trained law enforcement officers 18 who are tasked with responding to critical incidents where their specific training is applied to 19 20 prevent injury and death to the public and law enforcement personnel. 21 22 23 24

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Sheriff's Office is authorized to accept \$7,500 in the 2022 Budget from HS WEM for the Sheriff's Office to facilitate an intermediate sniper training course; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED \$7,500 is appropriated as additional 2022 revenue in the Sheriff's Office, Field Services Division, TRT Grant Training Revenue (SHRFFLD 80209) and is credited to the General Fund; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED \$7,500 is transferred from the General Fund to 2022 Budget, Sheriff's Office, Field Services Division, TRT Grant Training Expenditure (SHRFFLD 20135).
