AUTHORIZING RECLASSIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEATLH TECHNICIAN #2758 TO SANITARIAN IN PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON & DANE COUNTY

### **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Public Health Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) has requested to reclassify position #2758. This position is currently vacant and the Department of Administration – Employee Relations has recommended approval of this request. Reclassifying position #2758 as a Sanitarian will ensure that the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) 2019-2022 agent contract is fulfilled.

# Current Policy or Practice -

Reclassifying and combining positions of different classifications requires approval of the County Board.

### Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Due to changes in the DATCP 2019-2022 agent contract, position #2758 scope of duties is limited to collection of food/water samples and conducting short-term rental inspections; all other licensed food and recreational inspections/investigations must be performed by a Sanitarian. By reclassifying position #2758 to Sanitarian, it will increase Sanitarian capacity necessary for meeting the contractual credential requirements and inspection frequency.
