#### **Equity and Inclusion Plan**

In 2022, we updated our department <u>Equity and Inclusion Plan</u> (PDF) and submitted it to the Dane County Office of Equity and Inclusion. We expect that this plan will help increase our understanding of equity issues and how we can be a constructive part of a more equitable and inclusive department and county. The plan includes actions and ideas to increase the diversity of our workforce, and identify and remove barriers so that all county residents have equal access to our programs and services. This plan builds on equity initiatives already underway in our department.

The department has a representative serving on the county's Racial Equity and Social Justice team and also has an internal team that works to implement the Equity and Inclusion plan and share learning resources with staff.




- 4,026 free native plants distributed
- Since the program began in 2016, more than 19,200 plants have been distributed to 100 different groups, including schools, neighborhood associations and community centers.
- Volunteer growers doubled 46 growing in 2022


