Airport Decision Items

2.0 FTEs Terminal Maintenance Workers Added

General maintenance of expanded terminal (janitorial, light maintenance, snow removal and grounds maintenance, 2nd and 3rd shift work).

 \rightarrow Terminal expansion adding approx. 85k sq. ft. to come on line early in 2023.

1.0 FTE Director of Air Service Development

Added in 2022. This position will work on rebuilding commercial services provided by existing airlines as well as recruiting new airlines and routes to better serve Dane County and south-central Wisconsin. This person will also work closely with local and regional organizations to determine destinations and schedules that assist in business development.



Provision for PFAS & Noise

The Airport budget includes sufficient funds, including carryforward funds, for ongoing PFAS and noise research and remediation activities.


