## 3AUTHORIZING RECLASSIFICATION OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TECHNICIAN TO4A SANITARIAN I IN PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON AND DANE COUNTY

Public Health Madison & Dane County (PHMDC) has a vacant Environmental Health Technician
position (P6, #2758) which we request to be reclassified to a Sanitarian I (P9). A Public Health
Supervisor in the Environmental Health Division will supervise this position. This position is
currently vacant and the Department of Administration – Employee Relations has recommended
approval of this request.

12 The scope of work of the vacant Environmental Health Technician position is restricted by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection 2019-2022 agent contract to 13 collections of food/water samples and conducting short-term rental inspections. All other 14 licensed food and recreational inspections/investigations must be performed by a Sanitarian. 15 There is not enough work for two (2) Environmental Health Technicians, and not enough 16 17 Sanitarians to meet the contractual inspection frequency. Reclassifying position #2758 as a Sanitarian will ensure that the DATCP contract is fulfilled. 18 19 20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Dane County Board of Supervisors does hereby support and authorize reclassification of the Environmental Health Technician position 21 (P6, #2758) to a Sanitarian I (P9), commensurate with the Department's request and approval 22 of the Department of Administration – Employee Relations Division. 23 24

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that position #2758, which has been vacant for more than six
 months, is authorized to be filled pursuant to Dane County Ordinance 29.52(15), which requires
 the Personnel and Finance Committee to approve filling positions that are vacant for more than

six months.
