## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

Brief Description of Proposal -

Conduct a broadband infrastructure engineering study that will provide technical information and a plan for improving broadband service throughout Dane County. The consultant will also serve as a 'broadband coordinator' who manages implementing the plan, including helping local communities in project development and grants, as well as working with ISPS in coordinating public private partnerships and assistance with grant funding.

Current Policy or Practice -

Local communities and ISPs request funding for uncoordinated projects on an ad hoc basis.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Improve broadband service and access throughout Dane County.
