AMENDING CHAPTER 46 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, REGARDING PUBLIC HEALTH PERMIT FEES

# Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The changes in the ordinance support fee increase for revenue funded programs to insure that revenue covers the cost of the program. Licensing and inspection fee tables have been removed and replaced with general language and code references, limiting future ordinance amendments when fees change.

## Current Policy or Practice -

Current ordinance has 2022 licensing/inspection fee tables without reimbursement fees, and does not meet the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) Agent contractual requirements.

# Impact of Adopting Proposal -

This ordinance change supports the 20% increase in fees for licensing and inspections within the Licensed Establishment program. DATCP reimbursements are slotted to increase annually; and, per DATCP Agent Contract, if fee schedules are in ordinance, reimbursements must also be listed. By removing these fee schedules from ordinance, DATCP agent contractual requirements will be met and future ordinance amendments minimized.
