13	Cherokee Park Inc. intends to pump the water in order to irrigate 93 acres of turfgrass
14	between April 15 and October 15 th , up to 70 times per year. The pump capacity is 1800
15	gallons per minute and each application will be 0.15 to 0.25 inches.
