QUARTERLY REPORT FROM THE TAMARA D. GRIGSBY OFFICE FOR EQUITY AND INCLUSION (OEI)

Wesley Sparkman, Director of the Tamara D. Grigsby Office for Equity and Inclusion, reported on OEI's quarterly activities. See attached report presentation.

Chair Miles indicated an interest in OEI serving as the clearinghouse of resources on language access for departments rather than having departments go through the exercise each time of determining what is available and how to access it. Sparkman indicated that was a reasonable expectation and that the upcoming language access needs survey going out to all departments would help OEI target its resources to the language access needs of departments.

Sup. Veldran had a question re: OEI's work not being "complaint-driven." Sparkman indicated the mission of the office is to get out ahead of complaints and to put in place systems and training to avoid complaints when possible.

Sup. Doolan asked about language access support for HR during all stages of the employment process.
