7 8 9 10 11 12	Dane County Land & Water Resources Department (LWRD) recommends the purchase of approximately 34.7 acres of land in the Town of Sun Prairie from the Elinor G. Dushack Revocable Trust. This parcel is located on the northeast corner of the intersection of CTH N and CTH TT, is adjacent to McCarthy Youth and Conservation County Park and is within the Koshkonong Creek Natural Resource Area boundary.
12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20	The parcel contains a mix of cropland on the west, wetlands through the middle portion of the property and woods on the eastern side adjacent to the Park, along with 2 ponds on the northeast and south sides. The parcel's wetlands connect to wetlands on existing Park land and ownership of this parcel would allow for wetland restoration to occur. Acquisition of the property would extend the Park boundary out to the roads, providing greater visibility of the Park on CTH N and more opportunities for public recreation. The parcel will also provide a buffer from planned development along CTH N.
20 21 22 23 24	The seller has agreed on a purchase price of \$1,200,000 for the property. Funds for the purchase are available in the 2023 Dane County Conservation Fund budget. The debt issued to support this expenditure will have a term of 20 years.
24 25 26 27 28 29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby authorize the purchase of approximately 34.7 acres from the Elinor G. Dushack Revocable Trust for \$1,200,000 plus miscellaneous costs according to Wis. Stats. Chapter 27.03(3); and
30 31 32 33	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Dane County Land & Water Resources Department Director and the Real Estate Coordinator are authorized to administer the closing and the transfer of the above-mentioned property to Dane County, and the Controller is authorized to issue checks necessary to effectuate the transaction.
