Dane County Urban County Consortium

- ► In 1999, the Dane County population surpassed 200,000 residents which allowed Dane County to form an Urban County Consortium to receive direct funding from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.
- ► Later in 2002, the County qualified as an entitlement under the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program.
- Units of local government may choose to be included or excluded.
- Dane County must enter into cooperative agreements with the units of local government to be included.
 - ▶ The agreements renew every 3 years. The next period is 2023 2025.





Housing and community development activities that primarily benefit <u>low-to-moderate</u> income (LMI) persons.

Meet a National Objective:

- ► Benefit to LMI persons (70%)
- ▶ Aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight
- ► Meet a need having a particular urgency

CDBG/HOME Annual Funding

- ▶ Dane County is an Entitlement community under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) programs.
- ► The County receives approximately \$1 million in CDBG funding and \$500,000 in HOME funding.
- In order to allocate CDBG and HOME funds, HUD requires the development of a Consolidated Plan that governs how Dane County and the participating municipalities expend the federal funds and the submittal of a One Year Action Plan.
 - Maximum of 15% CDBG funds could be used in Public Services.
 - Minimum of 15% HOME funds must be spent in a Community Housing Development Organizations (CHDOs) eligible activity. CHDO's acts as the developer, sponsor and/or owner of the housing.
