Intent/Justification

The County Executive's budget includes \$500,000 in ARP funding for a grant to a non-profit organization to develop a tiny house village. This amendment increases funding by \$1 million using county capital funds. While the capital funds come with statutory restrictions, they would be a valuable resource to the establishment of a tiny house village site. This would allow the more flexible ARP funds to be used for other aspects of the project.
