AUTHORIZING RECLASSIFICATION OF A PUBLIC HEALTH AIDE POSITION TO A BILINGUAL- SPANISH PUBLIC HEALTH AIDE POSITION IN PUBLIC HEALTH-MADISON AND DANE COUNTY

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Public Health of Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) has requested to reclassify position #2840. This position is currently vacant and is classified as a Public Health Aide. Due to the need to improve customer service and communication in Spanish with the population we are serving in the Women Infant Children(WIC) Program we request the position to be reclassified to a Public Health Aide Bilingual —Spanish position

Current Policy or Practice -

Reclassifying a position to Bilingual requires approval of the County Board.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The WIC program will be better able to communicate directly with clients in the language they speak about nutrition education and support. Almost 1/3 of the clients in this program are Hispanic and Spanish is the primary language for a high percentage of these individuals. This change will allow us to provide excellent customer service while scheduling appointments, conducting assessments and verifying information.
